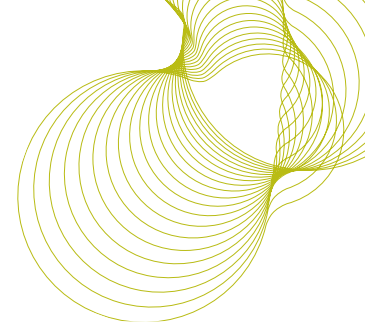


# PART L AND PART F 2010 AND SAP 2009 REVISION TO BUILDING REGULATIONS FOR NEW-LOW CARBON HOUSING



**In October 2010, Part L1A will introduce an additional 25% reduction of CO<sub>2</sub> emissions for dwellings, this is a 40% improvement over the 2002 standards.**
