

Energy – Lighting Template

Management Initiative	
Action 1 Label light switches	Help staff to select only the lights needed by labelling light switches.
Action 2 Lights in unoccupied areas should be switched off	
Action 3 Install low energy lighting	Upgrade lights to the most efficient suitable options
Action 4 Make use of natural light	Hospitals tend to have a lot of windows, this provides opportunity to maximise daylight
Action 5 Install occupancy sensors	Ensures lights only operate when there is somebody there to require them
Action 6 Switch from T8 to T5 eco tubes	Reduce energy cost, materials and maintenance
Timescale	Jan 2010 – Ongoing
Cost	TBC on a scheme by scheme basis
Payback	TBC by steering group
Issues	Awareness
Responsibility	Energy Manager
Measuring Performance	Sub-metering data, bills, measuring and reporting on quarterly basis
