

CE Marking and the Construction Products Regulation (CPR)

From 1st July 2013, it will be a legal requirement for construction products within the scope of harmonised European Standards to carry CE marking if they are to be placed on the market in the UK or Europe.

BRE Global is notified as a test laboratory and certification body and offers an extensive range of services to support construction product manufacturers, importers and distributors with CE marking.

The Construction Products Regulation (CPR) will require all construction products covered by a harmonised European standard to have a declaration of performance (DoP) drawn up and to be CE marked (European Conformity marked). Construction products covered by this regulation will not be able to be legally sold in the UK or within the rest of the Europe if they do not comply, even if the product is an established one.
